The flag of Great Britain conducts the history since 1603 when the king of Scotland Yakov VI succeeded to the throne of England and became the English king under a name of James I. At it was mute the new flag of the union of the states is approved: The Scottish flag of St. Andrew (a white oblique cross on a blue background) was superimposed with the English flag of St. George (a red cross on a white background).

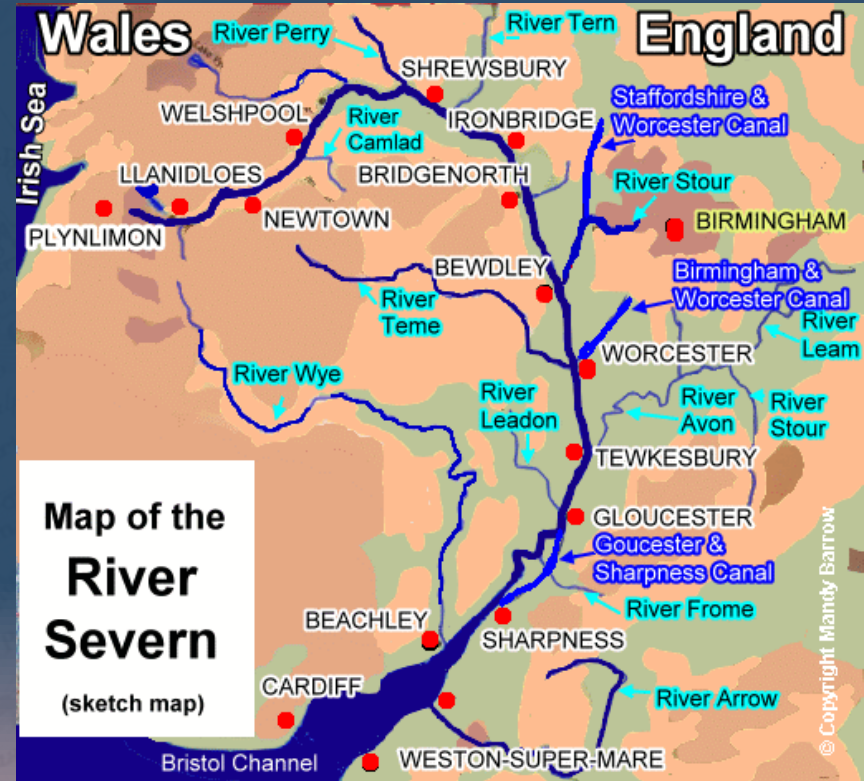
